## Reinstate unlimited Certificates for World and Continental Championships in Requirements for the title of FIDE Arbiter, to read

2.7.1 For World and Continental events, no limit for number of certificates. For other Swiss events: one (1) certificate per 25 players, or part thereof.

Previous regulations gave more importance to World and Continental events to issue Certificates for Arbiter norms. Here is chart in 2021 Arbiters Manual:

Rapid Chess	World / Continental	any kind	no limit	maximum 1

World and Continental championships have huge prize funds, give FIDE GM, IM and FM titles, and count more players and from many countries. The new regulation 2.7.1 puts World and Continental championships on the same level as a neighborhood Swiss without FIDE titles or big cash prizes, if any.
